Helping you with your Workers' Safety and Compensation Commission Claim

The Workers' Advisor Office is here to help you. We:

- Get information from the Workers' Safety and Compensation Commission (WSCC) for you;
- Talk with the WSCC about your claim and try to work out a solution to areas of disagreement;
- Explain WSCC processes and decisions;
- Help decide if more information is necessary to support your case;
- Review file evidence;
- Help prepare and present your case to all WSCC decision-making levels, and act on your behalf; and
- Help you and your family find other community services that might be of assistance.

The Workers' Advisor Office

The Workers' Advisor Office helps injured workers and their dependents with their WSCC claims. It is NOT part of the WSCC.

Helping You

The Workers' Advisor can help you at any time during the claims process.

We attempt to help provide support and solutions without having to go through a formal appeals process with the WSCC. If this does not work, the Workers' Advisor will help you get ready for an appeal. This includes going with you to the appeal to explain your case.
