This position determines eligibility based on legislation, established policies and procedures, and exercises independent judgment in order to provide fair and equitable decisions with the aim of facilitating the safe return of workers to the workforce. The incumbent interacts daily with injured workers, medical community, WSCC staff, employers, and outside consultants while promoting our vision to eliminate workplace diseases and injuries.

As a successful candidate, you bring to the position excellent interpersonal, communication, analytical, organizational, and prioritization skills with the ability to manage a heavy case load in a computerized environment. The ability to work with clients in a professional and courteous manner is essential.
