How can I become a safety professional?

1. **Taking WSCC's Young Worker Certificate Course.** This will provide you with information on the fundamentals of workplace safety.

2. **Once you start working, volunteer for your workplace's safety program** where you will get training in health and safety and valuable experience. Remember, you have the right to participate, and on-the-job experience will help prepare you for your career!
WHEN? As soon as you are ready to start working!
3. **Take a certificate, diploma, degree, or masters in Occupational Health and Safety.** Any of these qualifications will set you on a path to becoming a safety professional.
WHEN? After you are completed your secondary education. Some of these courses can be done while you are working!
