MINING CAMPS, KITCHENS, AND BUNKHOUSES

The WSCC conducted a legislative review over the construction, maintenance and operation of mining camps, kitchens, and bunkhouse as applicable to either the Mine Health and Safety Act or the Safety Act for the Northwest Territories (NT). It is determined that the NT and NU Safety Act and Regulations will apply to these worksites.

Bunkhouses, cookhouses, and other related residential facilities are not considered a mine as defined in the Mine Health and Safety Act.
