RISK LEVEL Refers to the chance (high or low) of a hazard causing a person harm.


EXPOSURE CONTROL PLAN Your written safety plan for your business or organization.

CONTROL **MEASURES/ HAZARD CONTROLS** The things that you build, make, or do to reduce the risk level.

HAZARD A danger. Something that can cause harm
