

# Stakeholder Engagement Feedback

## Policy 03.09, Psychiatric and Psychological Disorders

The Workers' Safety and Compensation Commission (WSCC) of the Northwest Territories and Nunavut is currently reviewing Policy 03.09, Psychiatric and Psychological Disorders.

Policy 03.09 outlines the factors considered when determining if a worker is entitled to compensation resulting from a psychiatric or psychological disorder that has arisen out of and during the course of employment.

Please review the attached policy in its current state and provide comments that you believe will benefit the policy development process.

### Comments

The WSCC may provide compensation to workers who develop a psychiatric or psychological disorder arising out of and during the course of employment. Policy 03.09 provides guidelines to determine if a worker is entitled to their claim for compensation resulting from a psychiatric or psychological disorder by outlining work-related incidents that are eligible.

Policy 03.09 is undergoing review as part of the Governance Council's comprehensive policy review plan. The WSCC is asking for your feedback on the policy's overall clarity and effectiveness.
